## SR 264 Burnside to Fish Wash Project Receives AGC Build Arizona Award

FNF project, SR 264 Burnside to Fish Wash, received a 2018 Arizona Associated General Contractors Build Award presented at the Phoenix Art Museum on the evening of April 27th.
